WEAR YOUR BEST

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COVER UP

Avoid items that are too tight or too short from pants to shirts and skirts. Skip the tank tops, sleeveless shirts and tees and spaghetti straps.

DON'T UNDERDRESS

Shorts, flip-flops and statement shirts (slogans, funny captions or distracting designs) are not acceptable for interviews even in the most casual of environments.

ESSENTIALS ONLY!

Carry a portfolio, professional bag or simple purse. Portfolios are amazing at keeping you organized. You can store your resume, transcripts, references, notes and other necessities all in one place. No matter what you choose, make sure you keep your cellphone turned off and out of sight with personal items.

UNSURE WHAT TO WEAR?

Visit the company website and social media pages to see what employees might be wearing on the job. It's also acceptable to ask the hiring manager or the person scheduling your interview what's acceptable. If you are still unsure -- it's much better to over dress and go for a more general recommendations formal look than to go too casual.
