### **Audience:**

9-12th Grade Agriculture Students

### **State Standards Covered:**

### **Example Assessment:**

- Student-developed artifact to demonstrate understanding of standard.

### **Questions for the Panel:**

1. What skills would your workplace want in a new employee?
2. Illustrate what it means to succeed at your employer.
3. How can students today prepare for careers tomorrow that likely haven't even been created?
4. What was your biggest successful choice as you entered your career? What would you do over if you could?
5. Describe the future of the agriculture industry as you see it evolving now.

### **Role of the Lead Intermediary:**

- Schedule Zoom Event
- Follow-up that Intermediaries connect/provide business
- Reach out to panelists to provide questions ahead of time. Ideally, hold a brief 'practice' ahead of time.
- Open Zoom Event early to establish settings (no video, all are muted, no name changing)

- Find an Intermediary to co-host (back-up in the event of tech/Internet issues) and monitor chat.
